Travel Requirements

VISA AND DEPARTURE TAX

A Visa and a departure tax are required in Bali. You are responsible for the payments of both of them at the Denpasar airport. The cost of the Visa for USA citizens is \$35.00. The departure tax cost is 170,000 Rupiah (\$10.00 to \$15.00). Please have the exact amount ready – the emigration personnel might not have change. Please check for Visa requirements in your country.

On the plane before landing you will receive the emigration and customs card. Please fill out both of them using the address of the Ubud hotel:

Honeymoon Guest House JI Bisma, Ubud, Indonesia 80571

At the airport, after receiving your entry visa, the emigration officer will give you the emigration card (white color document you filled and signed before landing). This document is required upon your departure. **Keep it safe**. You won't be able to leave Bali without it.

PASSPORT

It is required that your passport is valid and does not expire for a period of 6 months prior to your departure from Bali.

VACCINATIONS

It strongly recommended that you have current Hepatitis A and B, tetanus vaccinations prior to your trip to Bali with us. A Typhoid vaccination is suggested. Malaria tablets are not necessary.

POCKET MONEY AND SOUVENIR PURCHASES

The legal value of the souvenirs brought back from Bali to the US is \$800.00 duty-free. We strongly recommend that you bring a VISA or MasterCard credit card with a pin number for extra cash withdrawals or payments at bigger stores. \$500.00 or equivalent will be enough for on-hand cash upon entering Bali. You get better rate of exchange for \$100 bills (the banknotes have to be no older than 2002, and have to be clean from any stamping, writing, drawings, physical damages, etc.)

HEALTH AND SAFTY

- It is required that you bring your prescribed medications and any stomach problem medications.
- Bringing an antibiotic and anti-diarrhea medication is recommended in the rare case of 'Bali-belly'.
- Drink only bottled water for your health safety. Please do not drink tap water at any time. Brushing your teeth with bottled water is suggested. A liter bottle of water costs only 30 cents at local stores.
- One alcoholic drink is included for each meal. Any additional drinks are at the expense of the traveller.
- When in Bali, it is required to pay close attention to motor bicycles in the streets, especially their hot pipes. Contact with these pipes will cause very deep and painful burns.
- We also require that while walking or crossing the streets in Bali you pay attention to where you are going and stepping. The pavements are not even and have lots of gaps. When it rains, they are slippery and can be dangerous. Stairs are built unevenly and some of them might be covered with moss. Walking in one row on the opposite side to the traffic is strongly recommended for your safety. Never walk on your own the "Buddy System" is required meaning "Take your friend with you."
- It is your responsibility to inform your tour guide about your whereabouts at any time when in Bali or on the way to or from it. Do not leave the group unless you have received permission from the lead tour guide. In case of injury, immediately report it to one of the tour guides.
- Do not swim on your own in either a swimming pool or the ocean. "The Buddy System" is also required in these cases.
- Do not eat or drink anything you have allergies to or anything in doubt. Some spices, drinks or foods used in Bali might cause stomach problems or an adverse reaction. Always consult with the tour guides.
